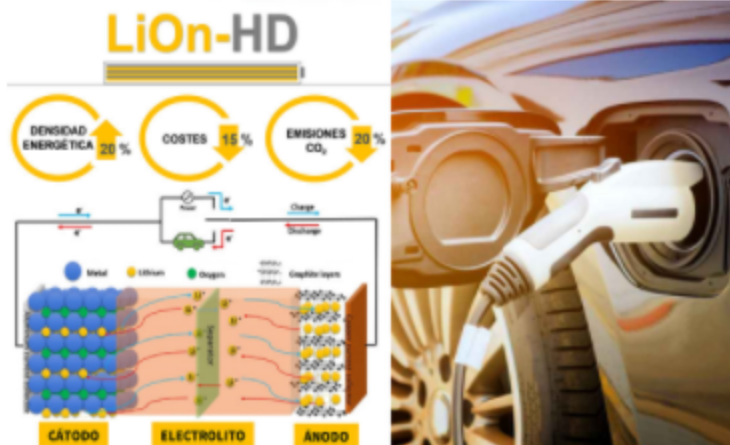

#### We research on future Li-ion batteries to boost smart mobility

We are the technical coordinators and main research center of **LiOn-HD project**, that will investigate the use of strategic materials in high-energy density lithium-ion batteries for sustainable electromobility. The project arises with the objective of significantly improving the energy density, cost and sustainability of lithium-ion batteries through innovative research in advanced active and inactive materials and their synergistic combinations for the different components of the electrochemical cell (anode, electrolyte and cathode), exceeding their current limits.
